#### RENOVATIONS UPDATE: THE KIRKLEA PROJECT IS UNDERWAY!

Now that the staff and clergy have set up their offices in our church building, the renovation of Kirklea has begun. Scaffolding covers the outside in preparation for stripping off old lead paint, replacing rotten siding and windows and putting on a new, non-leaking roof! Inside, the old radiators have been removed and floors covered as this huge project gets underway. #### **OUTDOOR CLASSROOM**

These benches will serve as a space for outdoor instruction and a host of other potential uses including informal worship. We're looking forward to putting them to good use during the summer months.

#### **OUTREACH BACK-TO-SCHOOL**

Summer is here which means that it is time to begin preparing our Back-to School program. The needed supplies are both extensive and expensive, costing close to \$100 per student. Our Outreach ministry assists 85 children from local donations alone. None of the Outreach funds are used for this program. We cannot do this without your generosity. For those who wish to become more conscious of the practice of spirituality in everyday life, this book offers guidance for actively living our belief in God.
