What: St. Paul's, Ivy Annual Parish Retreat at Shrine Mont

Where: Shrine Mont –The Cathedral Shrine of the Diocese of Virginia in Orkney Springs, about 90 minutes from Charlottesville.

When: The first weekend in May every year. This year it is April 30-May2.

The retreat begins on **Friday evening** when you check into your room in the Shrine Mont cottages. Stroll to the hotel for dinner followed by fellowship and s'mores around the campfire. You might end the evening by attending Compline, rocking on your porch with friends or just by gazing at the stars in the clear country sky.
